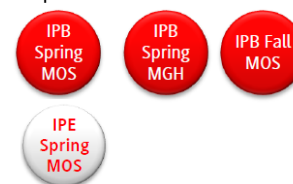

DHBW Mosbach offers intensive German language training and German culture classes within our so-called **German Language and Culture Immersion Program (GLACIP)**. This one-semester program (currently 24 ECTS, might be extended to 30 ECTS, if required by applicants, details to be confirmed) is laid out for inbound students from our partner universities, and includes intensive German language and German culture classes, as well as excursions and social events. Applicants should have some German language skills (advanced beginners' level = German language knowledge equivalent to approx. 60 - 80 hours previous study or A1.1 according to [CEFR](#)).

We welcome applications from exchange students from our partner universities with advanced beginners' German language skills (German language knowledge equivalent to approx. 60 - 80 hours previous study; A1.1 according to [CEFR](#)). In addition, a good command of English is required (B2).

Incoming students have to have sufficient health insurance coverage in order to enroll, see [InfoSheet](#).

In most cases, **EU nationals** have an EHIC (**European Health Insurance Card**) and do not need to take out additional health insurance in Germany. **Non-EU nationals** with valid health insurance in their home country may be exempted from the obligation to take out additional health insurance. Whether all requirements for an exemption are fulfilled will be determined by a representative of a statutory health insurance provider.
