Application Deadlines

IPB Fall Semester Mosbach: 31 May
IPB Spring Semester Mosbach: 30 September
IPB Spring Semester Bad Mergentheim: 30 November
IPE Spring Semester Mosbach: 15 December

Application Process

- » Application materials submitted by the deadline will be given first consideration in the participant selection process.
- » Qualified applicants will be admitted to the program / campus of their choice as space allows.
- » Rolling admission after deadlines have passed: Applications received after the deadline will still be considered. If all slots have been filled, they will be placed on a waiting list and notified if space becomes available.

Studying at the DHBW in Mosbach and Bad Mergentheim

The Baden-Wuerttemberg Cooperative State University (DHBW) Mosbach is one of nine DHBW locations. Its main campus is located in the town of Mosbach and its branch campus in Bad Mergentheim.

The cooperative education system, with emphasis on practice as well as theory, offers unmatched professional opportunities for students due to its close ties to more than 1,000 leading companies and organizations across Germany.

Two Campuses - Two Towns

Mosbach is located in the Neckar river valley, surrounded by ancient castles and steep vineyards. With its restored half-timbered houses it bears witness to its 1,200-year old history, yet some of the world's most innovative companies are located nearby.

Bad Mergentheim is steeped in history as well. Home of the Teutonic Order Knights since 1525, Bad Mergentheim is dominated by a mighty Renaissance castle where the campus is located today. It is also known as one of Germany's top health resorts.



International Program in Business (IPB)

Concept

The International Program in Business (IPB) offers international students the opportunity to receive a global education in Business taught by an international staff of professors.

All classes and activities aim at broadening students' knowledge in a wide range of topics:

- » Developing students' business, communication and intercultural skills
- » Providing opportunities to enhance international communication and cooperation
- » Familiarizing students with Germany, German language and culture, and its internationally oriented economy

Concept

The International Program in Engineering (IPE) with track 'Production Systems Engineering', enables undergraduate students to gain the skills and competencies needed to get companies on track to the 'future of production'.

All classes and activities aim at broadening students' knowledge in a wide range of topics:

- » Developing students' skills in the broad field of production, including lab practice in our Industry 4.0 lab, and engineering (including Automation & System Engineering, Embedded Systems and IT seminar)
- » Providing opportunities to enhance Process & Project Management as well as International Business skills

IPE is a one-semester program offered in Mosbach (IPE Spring).

IPE (Campus Mosbach): April – July

Key Features

- » Entry requirement for students is a 'near-bachelor' level (at least 5 semesters, undergraduate) in an engineering study course
- » Classes taught entirely in English
- » Modules in blocks or continuous over semester
- » Individual student research projects
- » Intercultural mix of students in class
- » Orientation program
- » Excursions
- » max. 30 ECTS credits per semester
